NATURE OF ROLE

An experienced Refit Project Manager is sought for Cockwells Modern and Classic Boatbuilding Ltd in Falmouth, Cornwall.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Estimating the time and materials required to carry out each task
- Create project plans for all trades to carry out the job within the agreed timeframe and the capacity of the Cockwells facilities
- Identify risks to completing the tasks within time and budget constraints
- Ensure that all Materials required are on site when needed. Identify materials required then, plan purchase in a timely way in conjunction with purchasing team
- Ensure a robust quality control process is in place and adhered to for all finished works
- Daily workflow management of all trades on the project including any subcontractors



- Be aware of potential Health and Safety risks for each project
- Weekly project reviews with the After Sales Care Manager for client reports and project updates.

- Must have previous Project Management Experience
