- Develop and implement commissioning checklists for production boats and yacht tenders, using Cockwells build information and existing 3rd party systems.
- Work with the After Sales Director to establish the expected quality standard across all departments/trades.
- Liaise with Sales Manager to clarify all optional extras specified per vessel and check all accounted for on-board before leaving production.
- Liaise with the Production Director for timings to plan and carry out sea trials and tests, as defined in the checklists making sure all vessels have adequate time afloat and under test conditions before the handover.
- Create workable plans for all trades to carry out any snagging/re-work before the handover due date.
- Be present at the handover of the boats to go through any emergent snags and operational/systems questions.
- Produce work to the highest quality within the set budget.
- Work with the After Sales Director to attend to any vessels with relevant warranty concerns that cannot be handled externally.
- Work with After Sales Director and Production Director to develop a pool of multi-skilled labour that can be drawn on to deal with any issues to the best of our ability, in the fastest way possible.
