Job Description

The Stock Control/ Stores Supervisor will help keep control of the stock and manage the running of our busy Stores Department with responsibility for a small on-site team (currently one other member of staff, however this could increase).

The right person will have an eye for detail and be accurate and thorough in order to ensure the stores department run smoothly and efficiently, and will be expected to operate the store front during stores opening hours and respond to any queries and requests from the shop floor staff. In addition, the role may involve some travel between company sites (within a 5 mile radius) collecting and delivering components, therefore a driving licence will be required. We may still consider experienced applicants without a driving licence, so please state this clearly in your application if you do not have this.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

- Booking in Parts, Materials and Consumables and recording entry on ERP system
- Replenishing consumables shelves and issue parts and materials onto the shop floor
- Control the booking in and out of company tools and organise repairs, servicing or sharpening as needed
- Supervision of on-site stores team (currently 1 other person, however this could increase)
- Travel between company sites (within 5 mile radius) collecting and delivering components as and when required
- Maintain regular communications with Stores department in other company sites in support of the entire business
- General housekeeping to ensure all store areas are kept clean and tidy

- Planning regular stock takes
- Processing returns to suppliers
- Provide cover for when other team members are on leave or absent
