You will have a through knowledge of Lamination & Infusion processes for small and major mould parts and be able to perform these skills at the highest level.

Responsibilities

- Assess overall capacity of the team to complete assigned tasks on time, adjusting resource requirements accordingly to meet deliverables
- To help develop team members to further enhance their skill set

- To ensure adherence to tracking hours and schedule milestones and financial budgets, managing efficiency of tasks performed

- To ensure the team is well resourced and recruitment activity is prioritized, in order to meet production schedules
- To ensure the facility is regularly maintained and machinery serviced in order to achieve production objectives.

- To always work in accordance with the Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 and to follow all company procedures and guidelines which assist this, ensuring site safety at all times.
